

GUIDANCE FOR Y11 STUDENTS CHOOSING SUBJECTS FOR Y12

THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- Use the Curriculum Planner on P7 and 8 of the Subject Selection booklet to plan your subjects for both Y12 and Y13
- You **MUST** take **English** – the English Department will place you in the appropriate level (A, S, or P) based on your 2011 achievement
- You must take a total of **6** subjects – have some back-up subjects in case there are insufficient numbers for your subject choice to run
- **You MUST check that you have the pre-requisites of the subject you are choosing – read carefully the pre-requisites in the Subject Selection book**
- Find out more about each subject you are considering:
 - » attend the Subject Selection Evening, WEDNESDAY 17 AUGUST, 7:00 – 9:00PM
 - » talk to the contact teacher named in the Subject Selection booklet
- Consult with your teachers if:
 - » you are considering more than TWO subjects in the same field (it is not advisable to narrow your options)
 - » you want to drop Maths (remember that Science/Computing/Technical careers often require Maths)

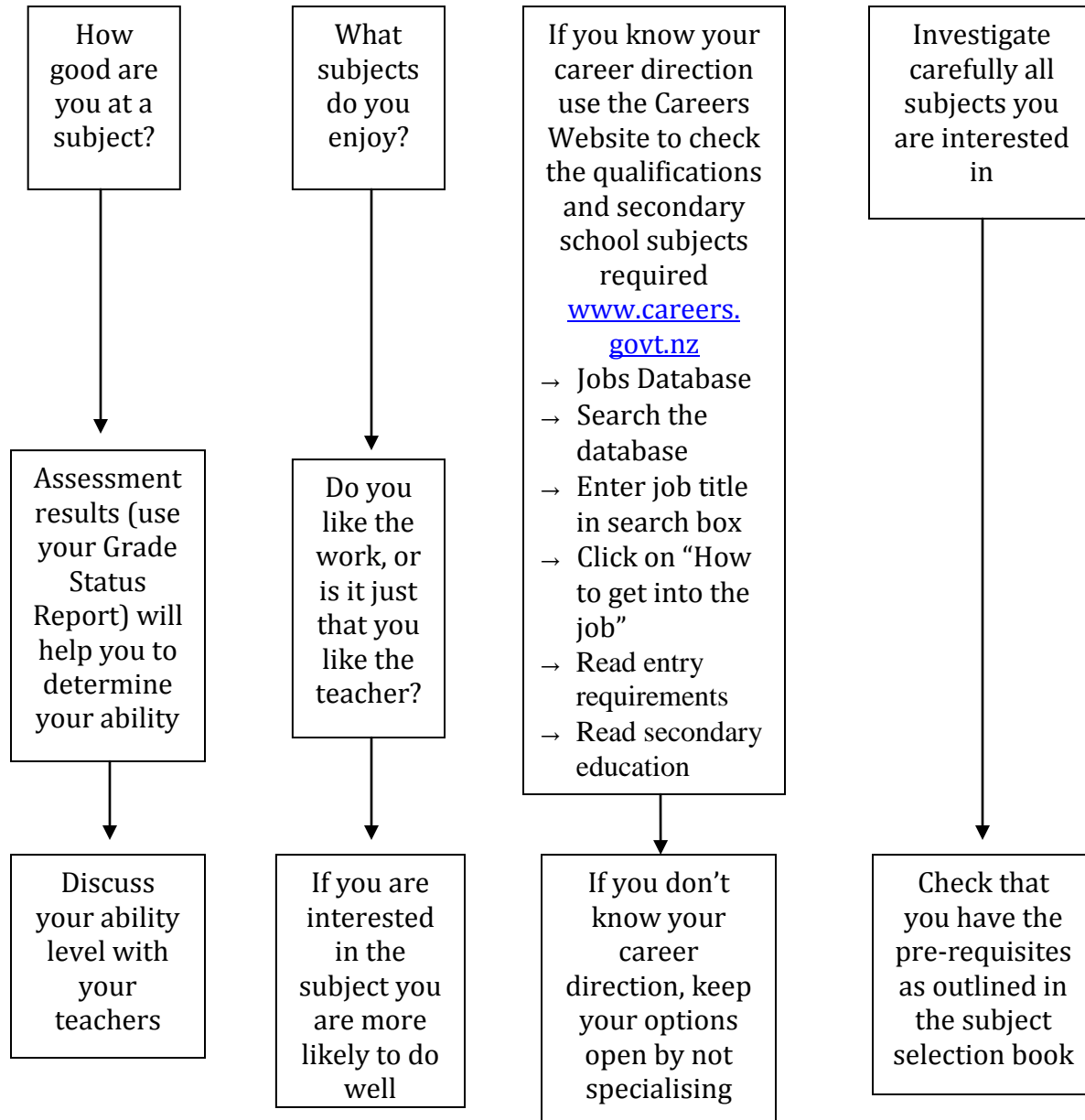


CHOOSING A COURSE OF STUDY
